

YOUR NEW ACCOUNT SUFFIXES

While 9-digit PFCU member numbers are not changing with PFCU's 2019 Systems Upgrade, the suffixes used with different account types will change. Please refer to the guide below to understand your new suffixes, as you may need to use a suffix with your member number when you are accessing your accounts by Telephone Teller or via It'sMe247 on your desktop or mobile device.

New suffixes will be active starting Monday, June 3, 2019.

Loan Account Type	Old Suffix	New Suffix
Home Equity Loan	L	820-824

Vehicle loans	V, m, v, a	500-509

Members with more than one account of the same type will see that their suffix has the next number in the account type category. For example, the new suffix for your first checking account will be 100. The suffix for your second checking account will be 101.

The new savings and loan account suffixes will appear on your next monthly statement.
